#### Timothy Team: Could You Be a Timothy?

**Could** *You* Be a Timothy?: Just as Timothy went into the world to carry on the ministry of Paul, we need to be involved in carrying out the ministry of our church and caring for each other. We want to try a new approach to meeting the needs of our church family who are homebound or just needing some love and care. It is called the *Timothy Team*. We would like to have a team of people who are willing to assume the responsibility for calling on our shutins at least once a month for about an hour.

Each month, we will be recording the worship service as well as individual greetings from members of the congregation onto DVD's. Timothy Team members will take a DVD to their homebound care partner and watch it with them. They will also have the opportunity to record greetings from their care partner that can be shared back with the church community. We are going to be a much more connected community!

Each month, after the Timothy Team Member has visited the person (or persons) for whom they have agreed to be a care partner, they will turn in a brief report to the church office. This report has a two-fold purpose. 1) It helps us know whether or not there are any special or specifically pastoral needs, and 2) we all tend to be more faithful in doing what we have said when we are accountable. It helps assure that everyone is visited regularly by both clergy and

lay ministers on behalf of our congregation. If for some reason a Timothy Team Lay Minister is not able to make their monthly call, they would be responsible for getting another to make that month's call for them, and to then turn in their monthly report. Is this something God could be calling you to do? Could God be touching your heart right now? We will have a time of training for those who desire it once we get the team set. #### Maundy Thursday: Walk With Jesus Through Holy Week

Between 6:30 and 7:30 PM on Thursday, Apr. 17, in the Family Life Center, will you take about 20 minutes to walk in the footsteps of Jesus? Pause at each of the places he paused-- from the Temple to the Upper Room to the Garden of Gethsemane, Caiaphas' house, and before Pontius Pilate. Pause to listen, to receive communion, and to pray. Wouldn't you like to spend some private, meaningful time with Jesus? What could happen if you did?

#### News From the Youth Dude...

**Big Shoulders:** Adolescence is hard, and Christian teens are no different. Just because they are Christians does not mean that they do not go through trials and tribulations like everyone else. This past month we've tackled some really difficult topics. Here's a quick look back on some of what we've discovered.

Doubt is a developmental necessity for an owned faith. Teenagers are in the no-man's-land between their natural adoptions of their parent's beliefs and testing of those beliefs so they can be owned. They'll never enter into an "adult" faith if they don't first question their "inherited" faith. We all need to ride out the storm, maintaining our own intimate relationship with Jesus, and try to answer the questions honestly and with passion. Don't discount or

minimize doubt, even doubt is a tool God can use.

"Cliques" represent power, and most youth are desperate to find more power over the uncontrollable forces around them. Cool, in many cases, translates to more social power. I think youth need to experience the power of Jesus first-hand. And the best way for them to do that is to first see Christ's power working in the lives of the people of this church. Together with them, make it your practice to vocally invite God into your everyday struggles that means you must "put your light on a lamp stand, not hide it under a basket" (Matthew 5:15) so they can see the difference an everyday relationship with God makes. When they experience real power - in your life and in their own it will expose the false

power of "social cool" for what it is.

Family bonds are a link to our beginning and a guide to our future. We all want to "belong" and feel accepted. A sense of belonging is derived from the strong bond of family, whether the family is one parent or two, grandparents, foster parents or your church family. Family is where our roots take hold and from there we arow. We are molded within a unit, which prepares us for what we will experience in the world and how we react to those experiences. Strong family bonds help us to thrive in all aspects of life. Lack of these bonds can lead to forever seeking that something which is missing. Don't take the value of family bonds for granted.


#### Spring Cleaning at God's House
